

WORKSHOPS

Workshops are a requirement of all courses. In order to fully understand the Montessori materials, you are required to attend a series of face to face, hands-on curriculum workshop days as outlined below.

Foundation Theory should be attended first. Once this has been completed, workshops can be attended as they are offered. However, where applicable, it is recommended that Practical Life and Sensorial workshops be attended before the other curriculum areas.
